Call to Order

Establishment of Quorum

With a majority of Gates, Security, Short Term Rentals and Transportation Committee Members in attendance, quorum was met.

Task Forces

Update – Traffic – Cliff McMackin

- Three segments under review to improve traffic situation: Sea Pines Circle, Greenwood Drive, Greenwood and Ocean Gates;
- Meetings continue to be held with Town of Hilton Head, Beaufort County Council and South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT);
- Traffic engineers to study all components, 15 years out, at minimum;
- Beaufort County Council to rely on Transportation Sales and Use Tax Referendum, 2024, to fund projects;
- Town of Hilton Head Island to prioritize and determine distribution of funds and sequence of projects, from funds allotted by Beaufort County Council;
- Gate entry software options, to include: cashless systems, POA lane, RFID capability. RFI to be sought.

Update - Gate Signage – Cliff McMackin

- Existing signage, ineffective;
- SCDOT engineers recommended overhead signage/mast arm signage, as most effective;
- Vendors identified. Signage to complement Sea Pines style.

Pass Volumes

Update - Gate Pass Volumes – Victoria Shanahan

Ms. Shanahan presented: Gate Passes, sold at the gates, January 1, 2024 – April 24, 2024; Decals, issued November 2023 – April 2024; Short Term Rental Passes, sold at the gates and through the Welcome Center, 2020 – 2024.

- January 1, 2024 – April 24, 2024/YOY: Total Number of Passes: 105,240/111,362; Daily Visitor Passes: 68,515/71,684; Commercial Passes: 30,176/33,880,

Short Term Rentals

Update – Rental Registration Program Reconciliation – Victoria Shanahan

- Town of Hilton Head Island, Short Term Rental License Fee Program, mandated;
- SPCSA, Rental Registration Program, initiated, 2023;
- FOIA request to Town of Hilton Head Island, for short term rental license fee program list, received (does not apply to long term rentals or timeshares);
- Reconciliation of Town of Hilton Head Island and SPCSA property lists, completed;
- Town of Hilton Head Island lists 1,621 participants. SPCSA lists 2,185 participants;

- Joint Registration Rental Fee billing process to be considered with Town of Hilton Head Island;
- Messaging to community on funds' use, to be reviewed.

SPCSA Trolley/Beach Shuttle Programs

Update – Heritage Tournament/Beach Shuttle/Trolley Programs – Joe Count

- Heritage Tournament week ridership: 13,491 riders as compared to 14,459 in 2023;
- Sea Pines Center to Harbour Town route, most popular;
- Trolley Program prepared for season/Memorial Day;
- Total vehicle entries to Sea Pines Community, through both Greenwood and Ocean gates, tracked at 224,863, in March 2024.

Unfinished Business

Update – Ebike Enforcement/Approved Decals – Joe Count

- Property Owner ebike medical exemptions, approved through SPCSA. To date, 20 medical exemption decals, distributed;
- Ebike citations in April 2024, 20;
- Ebike signage to be installed at beachwalk entries, prior to Memorial Day;
- Ebike literature distributed to rental agencies, bike companies, etc.

Update – CSA 360, NetSuite – Victoria Shanahan

- Rental Management module remains inactive;
- SPCSA meets weekly with CSA360 representatives, to address issues.
