The 56th annual RBC Heritage features a \$20 million purse, a limited field of 70 to 80 players and a no-cut format. Fans can expect the best players on the PGA TOUR attend including 2023 defending champion Matt Fitzpatrick.

The RBC Heritage continues to be highlighted by the PGA TOUR due to its strong title sponsor commitment, its storied history and its strong community support.

The support we receive from Sea Pines property owners is important to the Heritage Classic Foundation. We are thankful for the opportunity to share your beautiful community with the golf world.

Each year, the staff conducts a post tournament analysis to identify areas to improve upon. We strive to mitigate impact to property owners while providing a first-class experience.

Our operations team is working closely with Sea Pines CSA and the Sea Pines Resort to identify suitable locations to stage materials used for skyboxes, tents and bleachers. The goal is to reduce the need to use Plantation Drive.

New spectator bleachers have been added to the 1st tee, 2nd green, 4th green, 5th green, driving range and the 17th green.

An additional mobile ticket scanning location on Baynard Cove will be added this year, increasing the number of on-course entrances to eleven. All scanning locations will be tented, making them more visible.

Safari Telecommunications has once again been contracted to work with Hargray to increase public Wi-Fi throughout the entirety of Harbour Town Golf Links. Safari works with many other PGA TOUR events across the United States and excel at providing state of the art service at outdoor events. Also, Verizon will be bringing a mobile cell site for increased cell service on the course.

The TV broadcast compound will continue to line Baynard Cove Road. The operations team is working with CBS Sports and PGA TOUR Entertainment to mitigate the road closure to as short of time frame as possible.
